

## Parents' evening on the topic "Games and creative media work (2-6 years) - approx. 2 hours

Erasmus+ project on developing competences in media education for parents in rural areas.

WHAT?	WHY?	HOW?	HOW LONG?
Put out 3 tablets, each with the mouse app, the elephant app and the sandman app. The parents may test the apps.	Get first experience	Try out	15 min.
Welcome the participants and thank the institution for the opportunity to hold the parents' evening.	Welcome	Intro	5 min.
Ask the parents about their gaming experiences and possible concerns. Possible questions could be:  "What did you think of the games put out for testing at the beginning?" "Who played digital games?" "Who still plays today?" "What did you find/do you find so fascinating about it?" "What do you yourself look out for in games?" "What risks do you see in digital games?"	Introduction to the topic/activation of participants	atmospheric picture	10 min.
You present the content on the topic of games with the support of your presentation. Always take up the parents' statements from the previous atmosphere picture.  Briefly introduce your next focus topic "creative media work" and lead into the next practice session.	Background information and media education opportunities	Input	30 min.

<p>Briefly explain the stations set up and the Stop Motion Studio app.</p> <p>We recommend one station with Lego figures, one with simple paper and pencil and one where people can act directly in front of it, e.g. to "magical things away".</p>	Orientation	Stop Motion Studio App Introduction	5 min.
Parents can test the Stop Motion Studio app together and make a short animated film.	Make own experiences	Try it out	20 min.
<p>Have parents discuss their previous experiences and any unanswered questions among themselves. Invite parents to share tips and advice with each other.</p> <p>Collect the most important statements on a flipchart</p>	Exchange of experience	Group discussion	20 min.
Summarise the most important results.	Lecture	Merge contents	5 min.
<p>Summarise the whole evening again, give tips for media education at home and give website and book recommendations so that the parents can deal with the topic further.</p> <p>Finally, hand out your handout and thank them again for attending the parents' evening.</p>	Motivate parents to continue to deal with the topic	Closing	10 min.
